Supplemental to amendment dated May 22, 1936, it is desired to incorporate additional claims as follows:

set of switching devices provided with movable contacts for establishing including slipping friction drive elements intermittent circuit connections; and means/for varying the rate of movement of said devices in respect to the time interval between the successive operations of any given sircuit.

19. A switching device comprising components provided with electrical contacts, said components being movedly associated for establishing intermittent circuit connections; and means for varying the relative rate of movement of said components independently and differentially to shange the time interval between circuit controlling operations of any given circuit.

components, provided with electrical contacts for establishing intermittent circuit connections; means for varying said connections, including differential/driving systems operable with each of said components for randomizing the intervals of time between successive operations of any given circuit.

components, provided with operatively associated contact elements, one any of said components having its elements arranged in/axxandam order; and means for noving said components relative to each other whereby the time interval between the opening and closing operation of any given circuit is varied speriodically.

each pr vided with operatively related contact elements, and one of said fortuitous components having its contact elements electrically connected in a/random order; and means for varying the relative rate of movement of said components for intermittently and aperiodically effecting the operation of any given circuit.

23. In a mechanism of the character described, complemental each switching devices/provided with electrical contacts, one of said devices having its contacts spaced at irregular intervals with respect to each other and electrically interrelated for establishing a plurality of circuit connections; and means for independently and differentially operating said devices/to effect circuit connections at varying time intervals.

An important object of this invention is to provide a means of selecting from a plurality of available electrical sircuits a single circuit at random, which will be operative for a period of time, the length of the interval depending upon the variable factors such as imtroduced by the mechanism of the present invention.
