SUBJECT: Questions on Security

TO: All Personnel

- 1. There is presently being compiled a set of security instructions to be known as Post Security Regulations. These will, upon publication, govern the conduct of all Post personnel with respect to security.
- 2. In order that any questions regarding security which have been bothering you may be clarified, it is urged that all personnel give serious attention to the matter and after reflection, submit to their supervisors or unit heads, any questions they may have about what they can say or do, or where they can go on the post -- in short, anything at all which is not clear to them.
- 3. These will be consolidated and the answers will be, so far as possible, incorporated in Post Security Regulations for the instruction and guidance of all.
- 4. It is desired that all questions be submitted by 6 February 1944.
