BRIEF SUMMARY.

This Division has been authorized to place on war reserve 1,800 SIGCUM. All SIGCUM shall be modified during rehabilitation in accordance with Incli, wiring diagram ASAM 2-1. The modified SIGCUM will have the nomenclature ASAM 2-1 and new name plates will be provided. All SIGCUM and SIGHUAD presently in the field will be placed - replaced by the ASAM 2-1 as soon as possible, dependent upon the rate of rehabilitation and preparation of the necessary manuals.

1. This Division has been authorized to place in war reserve 1,800 SIGCOM.

- 2. In order to eccomplish this particular phase of the rehabilitation program, it is desired that:
- e. All SIGCOM shall be modified during rehabilitation in ercordance with Inclosure 1, wiring diagram ASAM 2-1.
- b. The modified SIGCUM will have the nomenclature ASAM 2-1 and new name plates will be provided.
- c. All SIGCUM and SIGHUAD presently in the field will be replaced by the ASAM 2-1 as soon as possible, dependent upon the rate of rebebilitation and preparation of the necessary menuals. Thirty of these modified SIGCUM should be equipped with synchropous motors, the remainder should have universal meters.
- d. One thousand eight hundred of these modified SIGCUM will then be packaged in accordance with the crypto-equipment packaging program. Four hundred of the 1,800 modified SIGCUM should be equipped with synchronous motors, the remainder should have universal motors.
- 3. It is necessary that this addification and rehabilitation program be initiated as soon as possible and that it be assigned the highest priority.
- 4. Inferentian is requested as to the estimated starting date, the number of units that will be completed within the first three seminumusl periods, and date of completion of maintenance and procedural manuals.

The following information in connection with the rehabilitation and revision of the SECCH is furnished for the information of all concerned in the planning of this project.

- a. The rehabilitation and revision of the SECUH to the ASAH 2-1 will be assigned one project number. The packaging of ASAH 2-1 units for long-term storage will be assigned a different project number.
- b. The 550 SECUM units now in the vanlt at New Cumberland will be processed first. Exact details as to the quantities desired on specific dates will be coordinated with Captain Toner.
- c. Property issue slips will be submitted to Supply Branch before 1 October 1948 for all items required on this project.
- d. The project will be started on 1 December 1948. This delay is owing to the time required to secure the items not presently in stock.
- e. As of 1 December 1948, approximately twenty-five repairmen will be assigned to the project.
- f. It is estimated that fifty-five hours will be required to convert each unit or approximately three years to complete the project. The estimated rate of production during the first three seminanual periods is:

- 1. A document, ASAM 2-1/1 for operation of the ASAM 2-1 both in normal usage and in one time operation is nearly completed. It could be distributed by 1 January 1969 easily.
- 2. We are the sepressed the opinion, in which I concur, that the machines should not be issued without new maintenance manuals, which he indicates in his paper will not be ready to go to the printer until 1 December 1949, at which time 720 machines will have been finished. All of this means that there will be no 2-1's in use until February or March 1950, (except for the 20 for Hawaii).
- 3. This Branch was one of the sponsors of the 2-1 movement because of particular concern over the security of our own ASA intercept cutfits. We recommended immediate replacement of their present SIGCUM's as soon as 2-1's were available. I would like to repeat this recommendation and ask that as many of the first 360 as are required to replace equipments at ASA stations be distributed as soon as produced. These could be accompanied by an addendum to the present SIGHOBY containing test procedure and circuit diagrams. (Note the circuit diagrams at least will be required for the 20 in Hawaii.)

It is believed necessary that the replacement of the SIGCOM now in the field by ARM 2-1 be initiated prior to 1 January 1950; therefore, it is believed advisable for AS-85 to consider the preparation of change sheets to SIGMOBY, in order that an interim manual may be provided, and so that replacement will be contingent only upon the rate of rehabilitation as estimated in subpuragraph f of Comment 2.

2. It is also believed advisable that this interim manual accompany the twenty ASAN 2-1 tentatively scheduled for installation in the tactical net Newmii in January 1949.
