## MEMORANDUM FOR THE MEMBERS OF USCIB:

Subject:

Final Report and Papers of the U.K.-U.S. Conference on Communications Security of NATO Countries.

- 1. The subject papers were considered by USCIBEC at its Fourth Meeting on 3 July 1953.
- 2. The Committee, with the exception of the CIA representative, who reserved his position, approved the conclusions and recommendations of the Conference. All members agreed that the matter should be submitted to USCIB for consideration in detail. The CIA representative raised questions concerning the delineation of "cognizant U.S. authorities", and the use of the NATO Standing Group as the enclusive channel of approach.
- 3. The points raised were discussed at some length, after which it was agreed that the CIA position would be reserved for presentation to USCIB at its regular meeting on 10 July 1953.
