- By direction of the National Security Council and delegation of authority by the Secretary of Defense, the National Security Agency is tasked with insuring the necessary degree of protection of the highly sensitive operations of this Agency and is charged to use established facilities and resources within the Department of Defense to accomplish this commission.
- 2. The Department of Mavy is charged with furnishing the Marine Security Force essential to the external security protection of the MSA effort at the Maval Security Station. Any deviation or reduction in this security support would greatly reduce the effectiveness of the NSA programs and could jeopardize the missions of this Agency, which, in turn, could affect vitally the national security.
- 3. The Marine Security Force, in support of the MSA effort at the Naval Security Station, also serves as a stand-by force for emergencies which require immediate action, and in which time delays could result in highly sensitive information being compromised. In order to serve effectively in this capacity, it is essential that the Marine Security Force either be billeted on the Station or a stand-by shift be on board the Naval Security Station at all times.
