It is suggested that Appendix F might be amended so as to give NSA and GCHQ exclusive authority over those aspects of this Appendix which are strictly technical,

Subject: Revision of the UKUSA Agreement.

AIR FORCE:

<u>Comment</u>: "The Air Force considers that NSA/GCHQ changes or interpretations concerning the exchange of and processing of Comint material which may be embodied in revisions and supplements to Appendices F and K are very likely to affect the intelligence content and format of the currently exploitable endproduct received by the intelligence consumers. Therefore, it is believed that USCIB should retain the right to approve changes and interpretations to these Appendices."

2. It will be recalled that the NSA member requested consideration of the reference at a future meeting, regardless of the outcome of the vote sheet action. Accordingly, this subject will be scheduled for consideration at the next regular meeting of USCIBEC.
