

I am writing to inform you that L.S.I.B. has agreed to adopt the following terms in its official terminology:

COMINT - (as defined in new Appendix B to UKUSA Agreement)

ELINT - Information obtained by intercepting and analysing non-communication transmissions.

2. The term SIGINT will continue to be used by the U.K. to cover both COMINT and ELINT.
