- 1. At its 106th Meeting on Friday, 10 September 1954, USCIB directed its Executive Committee to consider subject proposals with the view to making an immediate recommendation as to a suitable notification to the U/K_{\bullet} . The Executive Committee was also directed to examine the entire proposal and submit recommendations with regard thereto.
- 2. In making recommendations for a suitable notification to the U/K the Executive Committee was directed to consider the views of the Department of State Member. If he offers no objection to such notification the form and substance of it as agreed by the Committee and further approved by the individual Members of the Board is to be despatched to the U/K. If the Department of State Member does not agree to notification of the U/K at this time, the Executive Committee is expected to refer the matter, together with their recommendations, to the Board.
- 3. As a starter the enclosed draft is submitted for consideration on the assumption that there may be no political objection to sending such a notification.
- 4. The Executive Committee will meet for consideration of this problem at 0900 Wednesday, 15 September 1954, in the Conference Room in "Q" Building, CIA. In this connection Members are requested to inform the Office of the Executive Secretary by 1500 Tuesday, 14 September of the names of persons who will be attending this meeting.
