1. Although DS-616 does not furnish enough details for a definite judgment, it would not be surprising if the information quoted in Comment No. 1 should prove to be valid. Two systems are known which might have provided the basis for the low opinion of American codes.

- a. FOX code used by the Constabulary Forces, which we have evaluated as insecure in July 1954. (1st Ind to GAS51 413.46, 28 Jun 54; NSA serial 0805, 8 Jul 54)
- b. Low-echelon M-209 usage, about which we have received many reports of insecurities,
- 2. From a telephone conversation with Col. C. Helland of ASA, it is understood that Constabulary Forces may devise codes of their own which may be insecure. A request for details of such codes is being sent to ASA.
- 3. A series of questions has been forwarded to PROD for passing to NSAEUR, the answers to which should clarify the situation.
