THE CURTIS ANDERSON CASE

- 1. It is considered quite probable that the Curtis Anderson case will be brought up at the lOlst USCIB Meeting.
- 2. This problem was first tabled in the 12th USCIEC mosting on 4 March by STATE. It was agreed to refer the matter to the Chairman, USCIE with a view to holding a special Board meeting.
- 3. The Chairman thought that STATE should as quickly as feasible take all reasonable measures to cause the individual to leave Yugo-slavia, but that drastic action to remove him did not appear feasible at this time. In that this opinion coincided with the views of a majority of the Board members and had the concurrence of members desiring a special meeting, the Emerutive Secretary passed the information to the Department of State member.
- 4. The members were informed that STATE was drafting an urgent action designed to set in motion those steps which are feasible at this time.

MEA ACTION

5. FROD is preparing an WSA circular which will require that the Director, WSA be notified immediately whenever any evidence of possible compromise of COMINT information becomes available to PROD, WSA field units, or Service field units, whether from COMINT or other sources. This notification to the Director, WSA is to be made regardless of what other cognisent authorities may be notified.
