- l. The ettached document, "The Effects of Forld For II on the Ecourity of U. S. Meval Communications, has been read with considerable interest. It is an excellent compilation and discussion of Maral cryptographic courity during the war.
- The subject of the classification of TEOU seterial has been under discussion at Army Security Agency for some time. It had been the feeling here that all TICON meterial was TOP SECRET, except such individual items as were specifically excepted by agreement between the British and V. S. services. Recently this patter has been a subject of discussion by USCICC, the result of which was an egreement on a statement of policy which has been forwarded to the British for con-Bont.
- A minor connect is made with regard to paragraph 4 on page 6. It is gtoted that the Japanese intercepted all circuits which could be copied. It is recommended that the word "manual" be inserted prior to the word "circuits."
- A. It is requested that army Security Agency be furnished four copies of the first publication.
