Originally reported lost on 16 Sep:

Some rotors with wires cut.

Subsequent investigation showed no rotors lost.

SIGAMUG, Reg #92, found in tall weeds near coolie labor camp, 18 Sep.

CSP 1600, deg 732, found in Irrawaddy fiver, 20 Sep.

SIGQZF, Reg #1293, found outside hut in coolie labor camp.

Believed document has been in hands of illiterate only, and not compromised.

Other items still missing as of 1 Oct.

Concentrating on recovery of SIGKKK.

Appears that loss was not premeditated theft, but pilferage by natives who were in area picking up all they could.
