- (1) The Finns have recovered approximately 1,000 words.
- (2) After comparison with the following, it seems that these are from the same code book. For reference please wire us about a hundred words which Japan has recovered.

- (1) For instance, if the difference between the 2nd and 5th groups is 6405, strike off the 5. That leaves 640, which in reverse is 046.

Now, starting with the sixth place over from the intersection of 0 and 4 take off your additives. After every 40 digits skip 6.
