- 1. The USCIB Executive Committee (USCIBEC) at its First Meeting on 27 May 1953 approved the Terms of Reference for the USCIB Security Committee (USCIBSECCOM).
- 2. Notification of this action of USCIEEC was forwarded to the members of USCIE for information, under date of 5 June 1953, together with a copy of the proposed USCIE Directive embodying the Terms of Reference for USCIESECCOM. No objection on the part of any member of USCIE having been made in the premises, the Directive is considered to have USCIE approval as of 17 June 1953, and the Security Committee is thereby established as a standing group for, and under the direction of, USCIE and USCIEEC.
- 3. Pursuant to the provisions of the instant Directive, "the Security Committee shall be composed of one representative from each of the member departments and agencies of USCIB, to be designated by the incumbent USCIB member."
- 4. It is requested, therefore, that appointments to membership on the Security Committee be forwarded to the Executive Secretary not later than 29 June 1953.
- 5. Copies of the approved Directive will be circulated in the near future.
