I am much gratified to learn from Hear Admirel Wenger of your acceptance of the invitation, extended to you by him on my behalf, to become a member of this Agency's Scientific Advisory Board.

I understand that you have agreed to participate in the Borrd's first moeting, some details concerning which are set forth in Inclosure 1, the last paragraph of which you may disregard, as travel orders will be sent you within a few days.
