- l. The ideas presented in the attached suggestion have been proviously considered and discarded. In 1950, under AFSA, a study was made of the feesibility and desirability of consolidating the distribution of cryptomaterial by establishing joint distribution offices, or by having one Service in each geographical area distribute to all Services present in that area. This study lad to the conclusion that consolidation of Service issuing facilities was not advisable. DIRAFSA approved this conclusion and so advised the Director, Communications-Electronics and the Service Cryptologic Agencies.
- 2. The authority and responsibility of the Director, HBA, in the cormunication security field are presently identical to those he exercised under AFSA. Action has been initiated to extend his responsibilities under the Hational Security Agency.
- 3. It is possible that his COSEC responsibilities may be extended to cover the needs of the whole Coverment, rather than merely those of the Armod Forces. The ideas in the present suggestion may therefore be re-examined with the hope of finding them more useful under the new situation than under the present and past situation.
- 4. It is recommended that the suggestion be held in absyance for about 3 wonths and then re-submitted to SSA-Ok for reconsideration after the new CATSEC arrangements have been established and are operative.
